Let's create a cleaner future together on National Clean Air Day Thursday 15th June 2017

Did you know that air pollution on side streets is often at least 20% lower than on busy roads? Or that the most polluted place to be on the roads is inside a vehicle? As part of the UK's first National Clean Air Day on Thursday 15th June the City of London Corporation's Air Quality team is holding a series of events where residents can find out more about air pollution, learn how to reduce their exposure and discover how to tackle local pollution levels. Details of how you can you get involved are below.

8.30am - 12pm - Idling Engine Action Day

• Low Emission Walk – Clean Air Footprints

This temporary route is being introduced to coincide with National Clean Air Day on the 15th June 2017 and the launch of Moor Lane pop up garden at the eastern end of the walk. The aim of this project is to encourage pedestrians in the City to avoid busier roads such as Beech Street tunnel and take quieter routes away from traffic, whilst at the same time taking the opportunity to visit some of the wonderful gardens along the route.
